POST OF ANIMAL/BIRD HAZARD CONTROL OFFICER GRADE III

- 1. Job Scope** : The Animal/Bird Hazard Control Officer shall carry out his duties under the purview of Airport Management Division. He will report to the Senior Airport Manager (Airside) and carry out duties under the direct supervision of Airport Managers (Airport Duty Managers). Animal/Bird Hazard Control officer is responsible to carry out his duties as per the standard operating procedures stipulated in the Aerodrome Manual and also other relevant ICAO documents.
- 2. Key Responsibilities** :

 - Make the Aerodrome safe for movements of Aircraft from hazards caused by birds and animals, either in the air or on ground, using a combination of knowledge and resources.
 - Make the Aerodrome, mainly on the airside, least attractive habitat on over-flying routes for Avifauna.
 - Be imaginative and innovative in order to discourage various birds and animals that may encroach the airfield and take adequate precautions against future intrusions.
 - Enforcement of regulations to mitigate hazards from dangerous/vicious animals including Dogs, Cats, Foxes, Birds and reptiles.
 - Patrol assigned areas and take necessary steps to eliminate unwanted animals from the areas or capture them and transport them into appropriate location.
 - Runway inspections to be carried out as an when required in addition to the routine inspections and give clearance for aircraft operations to the control tower.
 - Carry out assignments/projects delegated by the top Management, Head of Airport Management, Senior Airport Managers or Airport Managers on Bird and animal control within the aerodrome. Also follow up on matters that have been identified as potential Birds hazards for aircraft movements. Use independent judgment to implementation of strategies to ensure that the aerodrome is safe for aircraft operations. Taking appropriate action to deal with recurring situation related wild life hazards.
 - Implementation of Bird surveys and to maintain records.

- Maintain required communication contacts with relevant internal and outside organizations within the airport to ensure safety of aircrafts movements.
- Educate the staff about wild life hazards and take necessary actions to eliminate the wild life attraction to the airport.
- Record all the data regarding wild life presence within the locations in the airport and process information as required by the Bird hazard control unit.
- Prepare and maintain necessary reports and records and forward to the Senior Airport Manager/Airside as required by the Bird Hazard Control Unit.
- Log all the incidents, the accidents arising from the wild life, investigate and take necessary precautions to avoid recurrence.
- Always be in the alert by listening to the radio communications.
- Inspect the Airport property including all restaurants to ensure refuse that would attract wild life is properly handled and disposed.
Responds to complaints from the different organizations, investigate and take appropriate actions

3. **Qualifications** : a) Should have passed the GCE (O/L) Examination in six (06) subjects with a pass in English Language

AND

b) Should possess Twelve (12) years experience in handling/operations of Fire Arms and Marksmanship.

4. **Age** : Below 40 years on the closing date for applications.

5. **Method of Selection** : Selection will be made after Practical test, Written test & and an Interview.

6. **Salary** : The remuneration package offered will be attractive. In addition, the selectee will receive attractive fringe benefits.
