Gratuity payment in accordance with the provisions of the payment of Gratuity Act 12 of 1983. Senior Lecturer Grade II and above are eligible for one year of Sabbatical Leave with full pay

Selected candidates will contribute 10% from their monthly salary to the Universities'

Provident Fund while the University will make a contribution of 15% of their salary of which 8% will be credited to Universities' Pension Fund and 7% to the Universities
