The Ministry of Mahaweli, Agriculture, Irrigation and Rural Development with US\$ 95.0 Million financial support of the World Bank is implementing the Climate Smart Irrigated Agriculture Project to improve the productivity and climate resilience of smallholder agriculture in selected hotspot areas in Sri Lanka through increased adaptation of climate - resilient agricultural practices and technologies, improved agricultural productivity, and increased access to markets in targeted smallholder farming communities. The project implementation period is 6 years and the estimated total cost of the project is US\$ 110.0 Million. The project implementation areas are in Polonnaruwa, Anuradhapura, Hambantota, Kilinochchi, Kurunegala, Moneragala, Mullaitivu, Puttalam, Trincomalee, Batticaloa and Ampara districts in Northern, Eastern, North Western, North Central, Southern and Uva Provinces.

Method of Selection : Shortlisted applicants based on qualifications and experience will be called for an interview.

Salary Scale : Salary is based on the Management Services Circular No.01/2019 of 05.03.2019

Conditions of Employment

Officers belonging to Government Services will be recruited on secondment basis and persons outside the Government Service will be recruited on contract basis. All appointments will be initially for a period of one year and extension of service will be based on successful performance.

Officers currently working in donor funded projects under the purview of the Ministry of Mahaweli, Agriculture, Irrigation and Rural Development with above qualification are required to complete a minimum of two years of successful service in the particular project to be eligible to apply.
