Responsibilities

Based on the assignment, the individual/team will be responsible for:

- Interpretation services covering English, Sinhala and Tamil for events (workshops, launches, meetings)
- Translation services covering English, Sinhala and Tamil for documents (reports, questionnaires, curriculums)
- Arranging their own transport where required
- Producing the agreed-upon deliverables in a timely manner

Qualifications

- Must be a Sworn translator or Certified translator or interpreter (Ministry of Justice / Any other professional bodies/etc.)
- Professional experience for at least 5 years as a translator or interpreter
- Degree in Translation or diploma in Translation preferred
- Prior experience working with the media
- Command of the target language at a Native Language level
