BENEFITS: Appointees to the permanent posts are required to contribute 10% of their monthly salary to the Universities Provident Fund, the University in turn contributes a sum equivalent to 8% to the

University Pension Fund, 7% to the Universities Provident Fund (UPF) and 3% to the Employees

Appointees to the temporary posts will contribute 10% of their monthly salary to the UPF, the University in turn contributes a sum equivalent to 15% to the UPF and 3% to the ETF.

In addition to the above salary, Cost of Living Allowance, Academic Allowance, Research & Development Allowance and other due allowances approved by the University Grants Commission

The appointees for Senior Lecturer Gr. I, Senior Lecturer Gr. II, Lecturer (Unconfirmed) and Lecturer
